



## **C-Card Quick guide for Pharmacy Distribution points**

- Any young person under the age of 25 is eligible for the scheme.
- They must complete the registration interview at the Registration point.
- When a young person presents their C-Card give them a pack of condoms (There are 5 condoms in a pack).
- Complete the 'Recording form'.
- Send the recording form to Youth Support Team monthly.
- Offer Chlamydia Screening

### **Other expectations:**

- Young people should be given a confidential and friendly service.
- Whenever a young person accesses your service for EHC you should always offer condoms at the same time.
- Young people who use the provision for Chlamydia testing and treatment should also be offered condoms.
- Monitoring data should be kept up to date and returned on time
- L2 services will only expected to be 'Distribution outlets'
- Have knowledge of/access to local sexual health services available to young people in the area.
