Open meeting

Chris Kenny, Public Health Director Nottinghamshire County and Nottingham City

Budget – County Council issued for consultation. Austerity grant – contribute by realigning to help with the Councils budget problems = mainly from reductions. Expectation that Public Health will subsidise the Council shortfall. Such as the substance misuse service.

PNA - County and City working together

PH grants

- £35M in County
- £72M in City
- Both Local Authorities are under significant financial pressures
- PH grant is ring-fenced, but will release funds to offset other LA cost pressures, although has to be spent on PH outcomes – such as children, trading standards for tobacco control

City / County joint working – now for a year and getting to a point of single PH senior manager working on an issue – e.g. Barbara for substance misuse

Stop smoking – should be one service and will be working towards this.

Reviewing contracts –

HWB – maturing – city and county are different – funds being given to the HWB to ensure social care money is spent correctly.

Obesity pathway consultation – extra money to children’s pathway (different levels of tender and tier 3 (hospitals) – not as efficient as could be at the moment.

Services in county and city the same – will have the same specification -

- What – same level of need, just quantity could be greater
- How – mechanism will be different

If delivery model is the same then should only be one service

Maybe allowing a pharmacy to run two specifications for one service so that patients are not penalised for where they live (cross border issues).

Smoking services – does see this being in Pharmacy – likes the idea of variety of providers

Nottinghamshire County Council – rolling over the LES’ – looking at bundling together services – efficiency

Healthy Living Pharmacy model – support can be given

Bassetlaw – asked Chris Kenny views on where contractors should be represented by -

Main points are that they have to look to Doncaster for secondary care but to Nottinghamshire for mental health, fire, police, community services, PH – 95% clinical interactions will happen inside Bassetlaw. Feel that probably more alignment with Nottinghamshire re the above.

Doncaster CCG did not want to join with Bassetlaw CCG when CCGs were being created.

Flu – uptake locally

Seasonal flu is AT – staff moved over from PH to AT.

Health check program –

Depends on how wish to do the check – capture different groups if ask ad hoc when people attend pharmacy rather than having a list and being invited to go into the pharmacy at certain time.

LPN –

LPC attend the meetings, feed into the LPN re workplans and help research. Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire are working well –

MUR/MDS discharge scheme with Sherwood Forest Hospital – first action

NH presenting paper to the HWB on community pharmacy and LPNs.

Transition

When speaking to Sally Handley been focusing on supporting performance management of contractors – LPC are keen to ensure that this is done correctly.

Substance misuse

There are many contractors not working towards the specification
