Notts LPC response to County HWB strategy – Attachment 2

Notts County substance misuse consultation – Attachment 1

NH reported that 60-70 people attended the consultation event (4th event with similar number of attendees at each). Alcohol is a big part of the contract being tendered along with needle exchange / substance misuse. Due to the complexity of the procurement process it is taking longer to sort so the County Council have extended the current contracts for a further six months.

NH meets Andy Perrins approximately monthly at the CC meetings.

AP reported that they were going to have more consultations but smaller and relevant to the different area within the tender e.g. supervised methadone, needle exchange.

### EPS Release 2 – Top Tips!

- When you know a local Practice is moving to EPS R2, ensure you have cleared down all R1 prescriptions - don't hide them by filtering, ensure they are removed, if you don't it will slow your system down. If you have problems doing this, report it to your system supplier.
- Make sure you have annotated in your PMR patients who require a delivery service, EPS will not transmit this information.
- Don't forget exemptions must be correct before you claim – if there is an issue once you have claimed electronically you will need to contact the Primary Care Contracting Team at Birch House to assist you.

Jules wishes to develop guidance - two page checklist – asking members of the LPC who have already gone live to look at the document and add points.
