• Emergency Hormonal Contraception (EHC) now to include ellaOne – A Locally Commissioned Service

(just behind the Blood Donor Centre - Cathedral stop on the tram)



The local EHC Scheme is expanding to include the provision of Ulipristal Acetate (ellaOne) as well as Levonorgestrel for 14-17 year olds under a PGD. The Sheffield scheme does allow pharmacists to become accredited via a self-declaration process, but contractors in other areas have found it really useful to have the clinical aspects of supply outlined.
