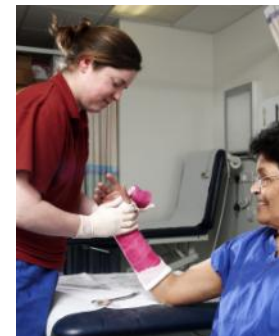
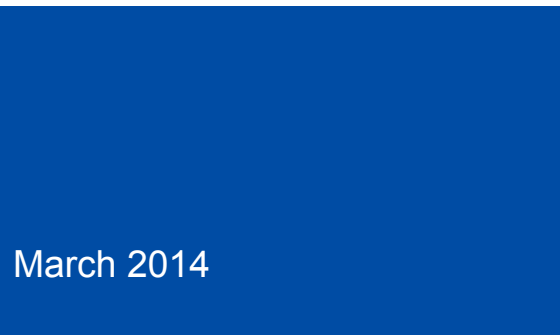

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Why all this & Why now?

- Pharmacy saying “We can do more”
- Increasing pressure on primary care
- Commissioners needing to use all the clinical resources available to the NHS

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Expanded community pharmacy roles...?

- Urgent Care
 - Pharmacy first approach
- Long Term Conditions
 - Supporting patients – medicines optimisation
- Public Health
 - Ideal setting – new commissioners

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Key messages from Call to Action

- Pharmacy acknowledged as part of the NHS
- Joint working with GPs – contract alignment
- Access to patient records – more than read only SCR
- Delivering consistency and continuity of services, standards and staff from high quality, fit for purpose premises
- Quality framework such as healthy living pharmacy model
- Harmonising accreditation for locally commissioned services
- Improving cross sector working – better links with secondary care
