

Pharmacy flu vaccination process



At the beginning of the day, prepare several clipboards with sets of the flu vaccination paperwork



Upon arrival of the patient, encourage them to start filling in the record/ consent form



A designated 'flu helper' should be on hand to help check and complete the form with the patient



Once vaccinated, the patient can be handed back to the flu helper to complete the patient survey/ stay in the pharmacy for a short while in case of anaphylaxis



The pharmacist administers the vaccine



The pharmacist should review the form and get the patient's consent



The pharmacist and flu helper should complete their paperwork and note the vaccination on the patient's PMR record



The required data should be entered onto the online system (if used)



The appropriate GP practice must be informed that the patient has been vaccinated
