Community Pharmacy Pressures	Contractual	For information	PSNC, NHSE&I and the DHSC have agreed several measures to help ease the immediate pressures on community pharmacies: • You will not be required to complete the Community Pharmacy Patient Questionnaire for 2021/2022 • The requirement for pharmacy teams to complete a national audit (intended to be on valproate) in 2021/22 will be waived • The requirement for pharmacy teams to complete a contractor-chosen clinical audit in 2021/22 will be waived • Further pause to the NMS Quarterly reporting - The requirement to submit data will be reinstated from Quarter 1 of 2022/23 (April – June 2022), with submission in early July 2022	
Pharmacy Quality Scheme	Pharmacy Income	Extension	PSNC, NHSE&I and the DHSC have agreed the PQS declaration will still need to be made during the February window, but as last year, this will be a claim for work to be undertaken and evidenced by 30th June 2022.
