<u>Information sheet for clients who do not fit the criteria for the supply of Emergency Hormonal Contraception</u> <u>through Community Pharmacies</u>

Today you have requested the supply of Emergency hormonal contraception; unfortunately the pharmacy is unable to make a supply of this medication to you as you do not fit the relevant supply criteria. This information sheet provides details of the options which are available to you and the actions taken by the pharmacist:

Reason for exclusion	Options available to you	Action taken by pharmacist
Outside the 96 hour window for treatment with Levonorgestrel but within 120 hours (Pharmacy unable to provide Ulipristal Service)	1) You may be suitable for an alternative method of hormonal emergency contraception available from pharmacies providing Ulipristal acetate on the EHC scheme, your GP or Integrated sexual health clinic. 2) You may be suitable for an alternative method of emergency contraception. The Copper Intrauterine Device can be fitted within 120 hours, possibly longer. Available from an integrated sexual clinic or sexual health clinic of your choice (see below). Some GPs may also fit coils, contact your surgery to see which GP's provide this service.	
Outside the 120 hour treatment window for emergency hormonal contraception through the pharmacy	You may be suitable for an alternative method of emergency contraception, the copper IUD. The Copper Intrauterine Device can occasionally be fitted beyond 120 hours, dependent upon your expected date of ovulation. Available from an integrated sexual health clinic of your choice (see below). Some GPs may also fit coils, contact your surgery to see which GP's provide this service.	
You suffer from a medical condition or problem which makes both Levonorgestrel and Ulipristal Acetate unsuitable for you	You may be suitable for an alternative method of emergency contraception. The Copper Intrauterine Device can be fitted within 120 hours. Available from an integrated sexual health clinic of your choice (see below)	
You have already taken emergency hormonal contraception (EHC) during this menstrual cycle and it is too soon for the pharmacy to provide you with EHC again.	You may be suitable for an alternative method of emergency contraception. The Copper Intrauterine Device can be fitted within 120 hours. Available from an integrated sexual health clinic of your choice (see below)	

Advice on emergency contraception is available from your own GP or from any integrated sexual health clinic.
