

### What is the criterion?

- On the day of the first review, the pharmacy can demonstrate a total increase in access to Summary Care Records (from Monday 27 June 2016 to Sunday 27 November 2016 compared to Monday 28 November 2016 to Sunday 30 April 2017); and on the day of the second review, the pharmacy can demonstrate a total increase in access to Summary Care Records (from Monday 3 October 2016 to Sunday 30 April 2017 compared to Monday 1 May 2017 to Sunday 26 November 2017).

### What do I need to do?

1. Ensure a pharmacist working in your pharmacy has access to the SCR on their smartcard - if not, check with your organisation or local RA about what further steps/training requirements are needed
2. Check the NHS Digital calculator (<https://digital.nhs.uk/summary-care-records/community-pharmacy/calculate-scr-use-quality-payments>) to see how many SCR accesses this period you will need to make in order to be eligible for the quality payment
3. Obtain consent from the specified number of patients in appropriate scenarios to view their SCR in line with your SOP and view the relevant SCR accordingly

### How do I evidence this?

- NHS England will accept an increase in SCR views from period 1 to period 2 shown in the NHS Digital calculator as evidence of meeting this quality criterion
- Make appropriate records in line with your SOP for SCR access (this could be as a note on the relevant PMR)
