

# FMD: What you need to know & do

## Issue 5: Less than one month to go



### About the Falsified Medicines Directive (FMD)

10<sup>th</sup> January 2019

- FMD comes into effect across the UK and the rest of Europe on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2019. Pharmacies will need to **verify** medicines are legitimate by scanning and checking them against the medicines verification system (**SecurMed UK**) and then **decommission** them (removing them from the system) when they are supplied to the patient.
- FMD aims to prevent the supply of falsified medicines – i.e. medicines that may contain the wrong active ingredients, or the wrong amount of the correct active ingredients.
- Medicines placed on the market from 9<sup>th</sup> February will feature an **Anti-Tampering Device (ATD)** and a **Unique Identifier (UI)**. (Manufacturers will have six months from the date of approval of variation to exhaust their 'old' stock and have 'new' stock ready for the market with the ATD and UI.)
- Community pharmacies need to be compliant with the new rules – this means registering with SecurMed UK, checking your IT systems are compliant, and changing SOPs and processes.
