

Supervised consumption payments for pharmacies from Thursday 1st October 2020

In April 2020, Turning Point committed to continue to pay a supervised consumption legacy fee to community pharmacies until Wednesday 30th September 2020 based on the previous activity as supervised consumption levels decreased.

In addition we also committed to pay pharmacies their actual activity fee if their activity levels are above the monthly average. These unprecedented payments ensured that pharmacies continued to receive support during the initial phases of the pandemic.

From the 1st October 2020 these legacy payments will come to an end and payments will be based on actual activity rather than the legacy payment formula.

Please ensure that all your supervised consumption activity is recorded on the PharmOutcomes or NEO360 platform to ensure the correct payments are made from 1st October 2020.
