Cardiology: Triple therapy in focus

Many patients who undergo coronary artery stent placement following acute coronary syndrome (ACS) and atrial fibrillation (AF) have an indication for anticoagulation and are prescribed 'triple therapy' (anticoagulation and dual antiplatelet therapy) for a specified duration. This programme will help pharmacy professionals in all sectors understand more about this complex clinical situation and their role to ensure safe transfer of care and adherence to the treatment plan.

What would you do if you saw these medicines prescribed in combination?

Aspirin 75mg once daily
Clopidogrel 75mg once daily
Rivaroxaban 2.5mg twice daily

How do you ensure treatment is safe and effective and the treatment plan is communicated appropriately?

In hospital, can you identify if a patient is on suitable triple therapy, relative to their cardiac history and bleeding risk?

In community, are you confident providing NMS consultations to patients started on antiplatelet or anticoagulation therapy?
