When we set you up on our financial system you will receive a purchase order notification about it. Please keep that information however you do not need to raise any invoices because the system will do that automatically monitoring your activity providing NRT products.

We will process your request in 48 hours and you will have the NRT Voucher Processing Template accessible on PharmOutcomes to:

- Accept NRT vouchers from clients and provide them with medication
- Record data on the system and get automatically reimbursed for the products you provide quarterly.
