

## **Pre-registration Tutor Training – online training via Health Education England**

Following our conversation –I have found there are several different ways community pharmacists can log in to **e-Learning for Health**

Four different ways to register or log in;

1. Register using your individual work email -Ideally you should provide a work email address so that your registration results in the most appropriate access to e-learning content. **NOTE** you should not use a generic or shared work email
2. Via CPPE - if you are not already registered on e-LfH and hold an account on the CPPE website, you can link to the e-LfH Hub for full access –just type elfh into the search bar in the CPPE website [www.cppe.ac.uk](http://www.cppe.ac.uk)
3. Log in via your Open Athens account if you have one
4. Register using a personal email -**NOTE:** Using a personal email address will result in limited access to e-learning content.
