

Independent Contractor Vacancy Community Pharmacy North Yorkshire Committee

Dear Contractor

Community Pharmacy North Yorkshire (CPNY) which is the Local Pharmaceutical Committee (LPC) is recognised in NHS legislation as the body representing all community pharmacy contractors in North Yorkshire and I am writing to let you know that a vacancy has arisen on the LPC for an **independent contractor**.

LPCs are committees with statutory powers and are highly influential. They are local leadership bodies representing, promoting and supporting the community pharmacy contractors that they serve.

If you are not the pharmacy owner or director of the company running the pharmacy, please ensure that you have the authority of the contractor before putting your name forward to represent them on the LPC.
