Hay Fever Treatment Update Feb 2019 – OTC

Mild to moderate hay fever/ seasonal rhinitis is listed by NHS England as a condition for which over the counter (OTC) medicines <u>should not be routinely prescribed</u> in primary care. NHS England has not identified any routine exceptions. https://www.england.nhs.uk/wp-content/uploads/2018/03/otc-guidance-for-ccgs.pdf

Most people with mild to moderate symptoms are able to relieve their symptoms with OTC treatments recommended by a pharmacist and self-care measures to avoid exposure to allergens. A patient information leaflet on hay fever is available: link

There is a wide range of OTC treatments available from pharmacies, supermarkets and other retail outlets. Generic or "own label" versions are usually the most cost-effective. There are some restrictions to OTC sale and so an NHS prescription may be needed in some circumstances.

Fexofenadine is not available OTC. Patients currently prescribed fexofenadine 120mg for hay fever should be encouraged to buy an alternative antihistamine OTC. Fexofenadine should be reserved for patients who are intolerant of or unresponsive to cetirizine or loratedine.

The table below lists some of the common OTC hay fever medications available. There are also many non-drug preparations on the market eg allergen barrier nasal sprays, nasal rinses etc.

Items of medication that can be purchased "over the counter" (OTC) are classified in two ways:

- P (Pharmacy only) these items can only be purchased from a pharmacy
- GSL (General Sales List) these items can be purchased from a pharmacy, supermarket or other store.

P and GSL items can only be purchased for their licensed indications and often in limited quantities. Please see above the circumstances where it will be necessary to prescribe an OTC item (if appropriate) as it will not be possible to purchase it due to the restrictions of the licence.
