



### Free access for suicide prevention e-learning

Health Education England and Public Health England have brought out a new suicide prevention course, “*We need to talk about suicide: helping everyone to feel more confident to talk about suicide*”. This is accessible through the e-Learning for Healthcare (e-LfH) portfolio through CPPE’s website.
