

Quality Payments: CPPE Risk management training requirement

Community pharmacy contractors may be required to provide evidence to local NHS England teams to show that they have met the Quality Payments criteria. This table can be used to record details of those pharmacists and pharmacy technicians (pharmacy professionals) who have successfully completed the Centre for Pharmacy Postgraduate Education (CPPE) Risk management guide and associated e-assessment.

When a pharmacy professional has successfully completed the guide and e-assessment, a certificate of completion will be stored in the pharmacy professional's personal record on the CPPE website. This can be printed to provide evidence of completion; contractors are advised to keep a copy of each pharmacy professional's certificate within the pharmacy.
